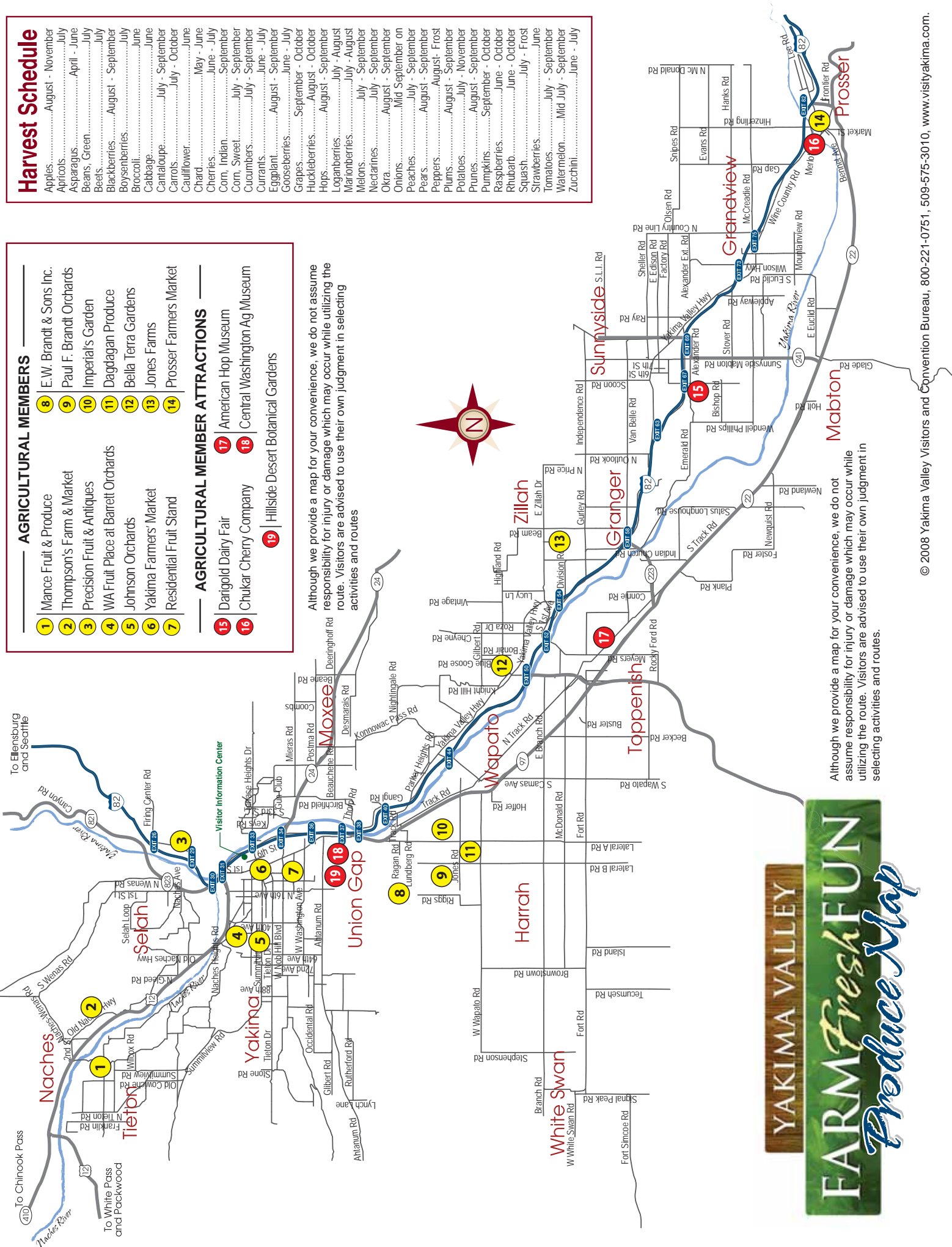

LOCATION: Take I-82 W/ US-12 W / US 97-US N and merge onto US-12 W via Exit 31 towards Naches/White Pass. Turn left on Ackley Road. Turn right onto W Powerhouse Road. Stay straight to go onto S Naches Road and go approximately 7 miles.
